

School Norms

School Discipline and Code of Conduct for Students:

1. Punctuality and regularity in attendance is essential.

Students who have been absent the previous day must bring a note of explanation through 'Record of Non-attendance' page of the almanac without fail. In case of illness a Medical Certificate should also be sent. Students who expect to reach home late after the school due to personal reasons must inform their parents/guardians in advance.

2. A minimum of 75% attendance is compulsory to be eligible to appear in the examination.

3. Students must come to school in neatly laundered uniform and polished shoes.

The hair should be trimmed and the nails must be cut regularly. Girls with long hair should make plaits.

4. Students are not allowed to carry mobile phones to school in any case. In case found carrying phone it will be confiscated.

5. Respect for school property and school belongings is an absolute must.

6. In the event of collective damage to school property in a classroom, the entire class will be charged the cost of damage.

A vigilant outlook should be maintained towards keeping the surroundings clean. All waste papers should be picked up and thrown into the dustbin.

7. Students are not allowed to leave the class without class-out pass and without permission of the teacher. While moving in between the classes in the corridors and while using the staircases all must keep to the left. Students should move in a way that no child is disturbed.

8. A student must speak in decent language all the time. He must ensure that his speech is courteous and polite.

9. Every student is required to carry the school identity card each day of the school.

10. Students are expected to bring the books according to the time-table.

11. English is second language for most of us, but it is also a medium of instruction. In order to acquire proficiency in spoken English, all students must compulsorily converse in English in school (and at home as far as possible).

Prohibited Behaviour:

1. Irregular attendance, unjustified or unexplained absence, habitual late coming, leaving the school premises without permission, disobedience and any type of unruly and objectionable behaviour.
2. Writing, scratching, engraving graffiti, drawing and splashing ink or defacing the school walls, furniture and property.
3. Use of foul and unparliamentary language.
4. Neglect of homework, disobedience and disrespectful behaviour towards members of staff or bad moral influence.
5. Making noise, talking loudly, shouting, jeering, hacking, booing, name calling, making cat calls, hissing, mocking and whistling at any time



Refund Policy

We Believe in Fairness and Clarity



The AESL works transparently. Our Refund policy ensures that all the refunds are processed fairly. In case, a student expresses his intention of not attending the course, and withdrawing his admission, we would require a refund Application/Grievance Letter from Parent/Guardian (along with the relationship) to be submitted to Branch/Centre in person stating the reason for seeking a refund. The date of submission of the written application for refund at the Branch/Centre will be considered for calculation of the refund amount. Parents/Guardians can also request for refund via mail to care@aesl.in. For refund applications via mail, the date of Email will be taken into consideration for calculation of the refund amount. The refund will be processed only in the "Savings Account" and not in any other type of account.

Note:

- Total course duration is calculated from Batch start date / Registration date, whichever is later, to the course end date.
- Future Installment dates will be considered as per the payment schedule shared and will not be as per the Loan EMI date (if any loan is taken).
- The discontinued student will retain Digital Access (excluding Google Meet) only if the Admission Fee is fully paid and has not been refunded at any point.
- The refundable amount will be calculated based on the total installments payable. If the payments made towards the installments are lower than the deductible amount, no refund will be applicable.

C NO REFUND CASES

- Registration Fee is NOT refundable under any circumstances whatsoever.
- Admission Fee is NOT refundable if refund applied after the Batch Start Date.
- Short Term Classroom Course Fee / Test Series Fee is NOT refundable under any circumstances whatsoever.
- Fee Paid towards Aakash National Talent Hunt Exam (ANTHE) and Instant Admission Cum Scholarship Test (iACST) is NOT refundable under any circumstances whatsoever.

Mode of Payment of Refund:

All kinds of refunds shall be paid through NEFT/Online Transfer ONLY. The refunds shall only be processed in the account of the student/parent/guardian as may be provided by the parent/guardian. The refund shall be credited within a reasonable time from the date of receipt of an application for withdrawal of admission by the appropriate Branch / Centre. The loan amount will be refunded to lending service provider based on AESL refund policy eligible amount only. In case any Outstanding remains with the lending service provider after refund as-per-policy amount then the same has to be cleared/Paid by the parents in coordination/accordance with the lending policies of the lending service provider. Under no circumstances, AESL will be responsible for the unpaid obligations or any other obligations of the lending service provider, which are governed by the lending policies of the lending service provider.

NOTE: The AESL shall not be held responsible and/or accountable for crediting refund money to the bank account incorrectly if the bank details furnished by the student/parent/guardian are incorrect.

Fee Refund Calculation Basis Scholarship Earned in actual exam:

- Students eligible for scholarships should submit their application for refund based on the scholarship earned along with the photocopy of the Class X Board Exam mark sheet on or before 26th July.
- Any application for Fee refund basis scholarship earned received beyond 26th July shall be rejected and the student and/or parent shall not be entitled to receive any refund under any circumstances whatsoever.
- The Fee refund basis scholarship earned amount shall be paid to the student/parent/guardian based on the eligible merit scholarship in the 1st week of August.
- In case of withdrawal of admission of Scholarship Students, the Student/Parent/Guardian shall be entitled to a refund according to the terms of the Refund Policy and there shall be no exceptions.


